


kayak; no reservation needed simply show up! I'll be waiting at the dock with my kayak.

Elementary Religious Education

Children in Kindergarten thru grade 2 will have their first class on **Sunday**, **Sept. 8 at 10:30 to noon**. Parents are asked to walk their children to their classroom each morning and meet them at the classroom at dismissal each day. All parents are asked to meet their child inside the building at their classroom each dismissal to ensure safety.


