



Boo received a bachelor's degree in advertising from West Virginia University and was the founding partner and owner of Fishtank Creative from 1989 – 2001. He is the proud husband of Aimee who has serves as a full-time health care and business executive as well as an adjunct faculty member at many local and national universities. They split their time between work and chasing their five children and their growing families as they most unloy their newfound joy as grandparents.




