

Eucharistic Miracles Exhibit

The Eucharist Miracles Exhibit will be on display in Sperry Hall from **Monday** 2/3 thru Sunday 2/16. It is comprised of 160 panels that include beautiful images and detailed descriptions of the Eucharist Miracles that have occurred throughout the centuries in many countries around the world.



They were documented by Carlos Acutis, an Italian boy who will be canonized as the first millennial saint on April 27th at the Vatican. He was a web designer for his church and school, who cataloged the miracles on a website before he died of leukemia in 2006 at age 15. He will be known as the Patron Saint of the internet.

With broken English and poor health, Cabrini uses her entrepreneurial mind to build an empire of hope unlike anything the world had ever seen. Cabrini explores the sexism and anti-Italian bigotry faced by Cabrini and others in New York City in the late 19th century.



As we begin the Jubilee Year and celebrate the 25th anniversary of the dedication of our current worship space, we look back to one of more significant experiences in the life of any parish community: the process of building a church.

In early 1995, Our Lady of Mercy's Pastoral Council began to explore solutions to address the lack of adequate space for our liturgical needs. Our original church home, built in 1946, was built as a multi-purpose building and did not lend itself to implementing the liturgical directives of the Church as part of the vision of the Second Vatican Council.

Come and learn about how the architecture, furnishings, and works of art of our current worship space, dedicated in 2000, was inspired from the process of liturgical design.
