



Would you be willing to bring Christ to a member of our parish who is unable to join us due to age or illness? We are




in need of Eucharistic Ministers to bring the eucharist to the homebound. If you can assist, contact Irene.

An Invitation to Explore the Catholic Faith






Christopher's areas of expertise include computer networks security, software security, embedded systems security, internet of things, ubiquitous computing, software-defined networks, cyber-physical systems security, and trusted computing. He has published multiple articles in international peer-reviewed conferences and journals, as well as been an invited speaker for various cybersecurity talks and workshops.

In addition to his academic work, Christopher served as a technical committee member and reviewer for several international conferences and as an assistant editor for the Cybersecurity Skills Journal. He is also a member of the Association for Computing Machinery (ACM) and the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers (IEEE).


