

#### **MERCY MEMORIES**

Our Altar is the central focus of our worship space. It offers a simple and square construction without surrounding barriers such as steps. The altar top is called the mensa and is made of solid stone signifying permanence. Four crosses cut into the corners of the stone represent the four corners of the earth with an additional cross in the middle marking Christ as the center. The four large wooden legs are symbolic of the four Evangelist....Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John.

Each week of this Lenten study, we will explore one of those signs and what it reveals for the disciple who is journeying with Christ toward the cross. This 6-week Lenten study will be offered twice, Thursday morning March 6-April 10 from 9:30-10:30 and Saturday after the Vigil Mass 5:30-6:30. No registration required, no books except the Bible. Participants are free to move between sessions depending on their schedule.






