To schedule a reshoot of your photo session on December 21, 22 or 23

1. Go to the scheduling website at: www.ucdir.com. Click on schedule your photography session on the right side. Enter Church Code: **pa888** and password: **photos** Choose a date December 21, 22, or 23. Then select your time.
