What is Sanctus: A Holiness Retreat?

Sanctus is a retreat for adults. It is an opportunity to deepen your relationship with Christ and with the Body of Christ (the Church). It is an opportunity for spiritual renewal.

What Takes Place at a Sanctus retreat?

The Sanctus retreat has a schedule that is sufficiently diverse to meet the various spiritual needs of the participants. During the one day retreat, participants will have the opportunity to:

- listen to spiritually challenging talks,
- explore spiritual insights in small groups of other participants,
- enjoy silent time for personal reflection,
- share group prayer in a variety of forms,
- celebrate the Eucharist,
- feast on wonderful homemade meals.

Who Can Participate in a Sanctus retreat?

Sanctus is open to any adult (out of high school).
