- Make regular announcements in Bulletins, both Our Lady of Mercy and other local churches

EXPECTATIONS OF MINISTRY:

- The members of the ministry meet at least once a year to update resources and share information
- Plan appropriate meetings or events for parishioners
- Be aware of self-help books and websites and share the information as needed
- Advertise the Diocesan Divorced Ministry and the Transitions Ministry
