GRIEF Ministry



MINISTRY DESCRIPTION/OVERVIEW:

The Grief Ministry provides support to anyone who has experienced the loss of a loved one, one of the more difficult things we have to endure in our lives. It can feel like you are the only one going through this experience, or that you are going crazy. This ministry provides support and helps you to know that you are not alone in your experience of grief. Sharing and learning that others have similar experiences, aides in the healing process.

ACTIVITIES OF MINISTRY:

We serve:

- Parishioners
- Members of the neighboring eastside churches
- Anyone who is referred to us regardless of religious affiliation

What We Do:

- Facilitate a monthly support group
- Make regular announcements in bulletin, both Our Lady of Mercy and other local churches
- Arrange for one on one ministry as needed
- Host a Ceremony of Remembrance in May
- Each November/December Focus on "Getting through the Holidays after losing a loved one"

EXPECTATIONS OF MINISTRY

A ministry member can participate in any of these responsibilities:


- Be available for one on one ministry as needed – time varies based on need- 2 to 4 hours a month as long as there is a need
- Participate in the monthly support group be willing to share your story, listen attentively to others. Time commitment is 1.5 to 2 hours per month
- Participate in the ceremony of remembrance in May. Time - 2 to 3 hours once a year.
- Address invitations to the ceremony of remembrance for those who have lost someone in the last 6 months. Time – 2 hours once a year.
- Become a substitute facilitator for the group.
